1. Who may use the Pool

a. **Member**

- i. Any Reno Elk with a valid Membership Card.
- ii. Any Associate Member with a valid Membership Card.
- iii. Any Reno Emblem Club Member with a valid Membership Card.

b. Spouse/Significant Other

i. Must have a valid Identification Card issued by the Reno Elks Lodge.

Member and Spouses/Significant Other are responsible for violations of the pool rules by family members and their guest.

c. Invited Guest

- i. Any person/persons accompanied by either a Member or their Spouse/Significant Other.
- ii. Visiting Elks can become an Associate Member or be a guest of a Reno Elk.
- iii. Maximum number of guests **is limited to FOUR (4)-** A guest is defined as a immediate family member. (Spouse/Significant Other, Son, Daughter, Stepson, Stepdaughter & Grandchild) unless by prior written approval by either the Exalted Ruler, Pool Manager, or the Lodge Secretary
 - iv. Fees for guests are set by the Reno Elks Lodge Board.

2. Hours of Operation

- a. Members only from 6:00 AM 9:30 AM Monday-Sunday.
- b. Swimming Lessons from 9:45AM to 10:45AM

No Children or non-Members until after 11:AM. (In other words, anyone who is not a member may not enter the Pool Gate Entrance until 11:AM) except for Swimming Lessons from 9:45am -10:45am. Between 10:45am and 11:00am the pool area will be cleared of all members/participants

- b. Members, Spouses/Significant Other and Guests 11:00 AM- 7:00 PM Monday Sunday.
- c. Members, Spouses/Significant Other and Guests open until 9 PM; 4th and 5th Thursdays Family Swim Nights.
- **3.** <u>NO Lifeguards are on duty</u>; Swim at Your Own Risk; and **children under 14 MUST** be in direct supervision by their member always.
- 4. Reno Elks Lodge #597 House Rules apply to the Swimming Pool and the following will be observed.

Obey the Cabana and Slide Rules

- a. No running on the pool deck.
- b. No glass containers on either the upper or lower pool deck.
- c. No food on the lower pool deck. Exception: (Cabanas)
- e. Drinks are permitted on the lower deck along the planter walls.
- d. No outside food including snacks without prior approval.
- e. No ice chests and no outside drinks/alcoholic beverages allowed.
- d. Appropriate swim attire / trunks is required. (No underwear allowed)
- 5. Intentional misuse of pool equipment or disobeying the pool rules will be grounds for immediate termination of pool privileges.

Members, Spouse/Significant Other and Guests are expected to clean up after themselves. This includes the tables, Cabanas, pool area and bathrooms. **Remember this our Pool and Lodge.**

- 6. These pool rules are an addendum to the House Rules; a copy of the entire House Rules may be obtained in the office.
- 7. Shirt and shoes are required to enter the Lodge.
- 8. No one under 21 allowed in the bar area.
- 9. Smoking & Vaping Area is designated to be at the West Area near the Racquet Ball Building (See Signs).
- 10. A violation of these rules will be sent to the House Committee for review and action.
- 11. The Reno Elks Lodge #597 is a private Lodge and reserves the right to refuse service to anyone.

Accessing the Reno Elks Pool

- 1. Entering the pool facility is through the Pool Gate Entrance ONLY.
- 2. Pool access is **NOT Permitted** through the Main Front Entrance of the Lodge.
- 3. The Member, Spouse/Significant Other or Associate Member must present their Reno Lodge membership card or associate membership card to enter the pool.
- 4. Emblem Club Members must present the Emblem Club Membership Card, issued by the Reno Emblem Club.
- 5. One through four above is free to all Reno Elk Members.
- 6. The Member's family member under 20, with the number of their children stated on their Membership card.
- 7. Guests of the Member or Spouse/Significant Other will be assessed a daily fee of \$10 for children over the age of 5 and \$15 for adults 21 years of age and older.
- 8. To receive a pool stamp or a pool pass, the Pool, Cabana & Slide Rules MUST be read, understood, AND the pool ledger signed.

To all Elks and Family Pool Pass users:

- Member and Spouse/Significant Other will be admitted free of charge upon presenting their Membership Card,
 Spouse Card/Significant Other and Family Pool Pass (see below).
- 2. **The Family Pool Pass will cost \$100.00** and will allow the Member or Spouse/Significant Other to bring Four (4) guests. A "guest" is defined as a immediate family member. (Son, Daughter, Stepson, Stepdaughter & Grandchild).
- 3. A fee of \$10.00 will be charged for each non-family individual over the age of 5 to the age of 20. A fee of \$15.00 will be charged for each individual 21 years of age or older.
- 4. Pool Rules have been revised. They are to be strictly adhered to. Spouse Card/Significant Other (free) and Family Pool Passes (\$100.00 each) are available online during dues renewal and at the Pool office when it is open (Additional times to be determined).

The Reno Elks Lodge: wants everyone to enjoy and participate in the success of our Pool. A couple of reminders worth mentioning to ensure our success and enjoyment this year at the Elks Pool.

1. When Member Elks, Spouse/Significant Other and their guests, acting in less than a civil manner with our hired Pool Staff, calling them names, rude conduct and just plain refusal of showing their membership card and paying for a guest is not acceptable conduct.

Our Pool Staff are hired to do a specific job and it is not their responsibility or authority to make exceptions.

<u>If a member has a request that is outside the Pool Rules, they should be in contact with the Exalted Ruler, Lodge Secretary, or Pool Manager prior to taking an action outside of the rules.</u> No reasonable request will be denied.

- 2. Remember, Your Membership Card is a means of Identification, it shows that you are a member in good standing, that it should be carried with you at all times, and that you cannot gain admission to this Lodge without one, additionally, it is a requirement to gain admission to our pool.
- 3. Every year the lodge is looking for volunteers to assist at the pool.

Assistance is needed from anyone with pool or spa servicing experience.

We are also looking for adults who can from time to time help with light janitorial work, which includes morning cleaning the pool deck, party zone, upper pool deck and the shower rooms to get the pool ready each day.

Give an hour a day, as many days a week that you might be willing to volunteer; your assistance will always be appreciated.
